

Licensure or Certification Requirements

Nationally accredited personal training certification exams (CPT) are not a requirement for graduation from Focus Personal Training Institute (FPTI), though some employers may require a national certification as a condition of employment.

As the personal fitness training profession is currently an unlicensed and unregulated industry, there are no state licensure requirements for employment.

NCCA-accredited CPT certifications are a recognized industry standard for personal trainers. By signing the Enrollment Agreement, students acknowledge that FPTI strongly recommends graduates obtain NCCA-accredited certifications as soon as possible after graduation.
